Meaning of the Belt Colors

- Colors in the Moo Duk Kwan flag are the same as those used in the belt ranking system.

Color	Season	Meaning
White	Winter	Emptiness, innocence, hidden potential, purity
Orange	Between Winter & Spring	Orange was officially added in 1975, under the Grandmaster's approval, as an extra step between white and green belts.
Green	Spring	Growth, advancement
Red	Summer	Ripening, "Yang", active
Blue	Autumn	Harvest, maturity, "Um", passive
